

# Type of Admission

## UB-04 Form Locator 14

<b>1</b>	<b>Emergency</b>	The patient requires immediate medical intervention as a result of severe, life threatening or potentially disabling conditions.
<b>2</b>	<b>Urgent</b>	The patient requires immediate attention for the care and treatment of a physical or mental disorder. Generally the patient is admitted to the first available and suitable accommodation.
<b>3</b>	<b>Elective</b>	The patient's condition permits time for services to be scheduled.
<b>4</b>	<b>Newborn</b>	Baby's first admission upon their birth. <i>Must use Point of Origin either "5"- Born inside this hospital or "6" Born outside this hospital.</i> (See Appendix III)
<b>5</b>	<b>Trauma Center</b>	Visit to a trauma center/hospital as licensed or designated by the state or local government authority authorized to do so, or as verified by the American College of Surgeons <u>and</u> involving trauma activation. (Use <b>Revenue Code 068x</b> to capture trauma activation charges.)
<b>6 – 8</b>		Reserved for assignment by the NUBC.
<b>9</b>	<b>Information Not Available</b>	The hospital does not have this information in its records.
