WHAIC Updates

Foundations of Wisdom from the Focus Groups

Thank you to all who were able to join us for the focus group discussions over the past few months. We are so grateful for the positive working partnerships and collaborations that were shared. Your contribution to the discussions were invaluable in helping us understand some of your struggles and appreciate the challenges you face with the current text file.

This forum also allowed for a few unplanned changes we are proud to support and share in more detail below, such as NPI changes, adding a summary profile report to WIpop and facilitating Data User Group meetings in 2017.

Jean Doeringsfeld, vice president of the Information Center, is sharing a summary of your recommendations and opinions with the senior leadership at WHA. A separate communication will be made in December on that.

Long anticipated NPI Changes are coming!

In September we reported that one of the many advantages of the Health Care Modernization Act is that WHAIC will be able to collect and report on more provider types in the outpatient surgery and inpatient data, including most of the qualified health care providers, (e.g. dentist (DDS), doctor of podiatry medicine (DPM), etc.) instead of reporting ten zeroes.

Effective with Q1 data - January 1, 2017 dates of service, the collection and reporting process for NPIs will change. We will no longer require reporting of NPI numbers nor will you be required to map your non MD/DO providers to all zeroes in the inpatient and outpatient surgery data. All NPI numbers will be accepted and validated through an internal process. WHAIC staff is still working out some of the internal procedural details for the process change and will share more information in the coming months.

Please note Q4 2016 will continue to follow the <u>current process</u> and the edit is still in effect for non-MD/DO in the inpatient and outpatient surgery data. Send your NPIs to the <u>whainfocenter@wha.org</u> in the Excel format.

Did you know?

Once you submit your data in WIpop, you have the ability to run the validation reports you normally download at the close of the quarter. Simply go to the upper right tool bar in WIpop and click on Batch/Reports then choose Create Report from the drop down menu. The WIpop Help button has more information on all of the validation reports.

And, more good news--as of Q4 2016, we are also adding the Summary Profile Report to WIpop. In addition to the graphs, charts and tables, the first page has been revised to provide an immediate overview of what your Affirmation Statement will encompass. Another change is that declined and unavailable reporting of race and

ethnicity is more predominantly identified. This will allow users and submitters to take more immediate corrective action. We understand that recognizing issues in the data during the submission process is a shared goal and we appreciate that! Providing a summary of the data submitted will help reduce the amount of time needed to address issues during the validation process at the end of the quarter.

WIpop Reminders

- 1) As we near the end of the year, we want to remind everyone to include their 3-digit facility ID number (found in Appendix I of the WIpop Manual) in the subject line or in the body of your email messages. Having the 3-digit facility ID will enable us to answer your questions more quickly.
- 2) Verification of WIpop Users Please remember your facility is responsible for verifying your list of registered WIpop users. Should you find that changes are needed, contact WHAIC so we can correct it.
- 3) External cause codes ICD-10 range V00 Y99 are statutorily required to be reported on records containing injury codes in the S00-T88 (with exceptions to the T range). See the WIpop Manual data parameters pg. 8 & 9 for more information on what is required.
- 4) Gender-specific edits most frequently occur with diagnosis and procedure code-related edits. Typically, these are related to transgender patients. As of Q2 2016, Gender may be 'U' if the patient has an ambiguous gender or is transgender. Condition Code 45 must be used in Condition Code 2 or 3 field to override the edit in WIpop.
